The **Imboden/North Railroad Street River Bore** project consists of approximately 475 L.F of 10-inch HDPE by HDD method and installation of (2) - 10-inch x 6-inch connections to existing waterlines.

A non-mandatory pre-bid conference will be held on June 16, 2026 at 2:00 PM in the WCSA Board Room.

Bidders and subcontractors are required under Title 54, Chapter 11, Code of Virginia (1950) to have a contractor's license appropriate for value of work performed. The bidder shall place on the outside of the envelope containing the bid and on the bid form, the license classification held, and the Virginia license number.

MBE/WBE firms are encouraged to submit bids. Bidders must comply with the following: The President's Executive Order # 11246 prohibiting discrimination in employment regarding race, color, creed, sex, or national origin; the President's Executive Orders # 12138 and 11625 regarding utilization of MBE/WBE firms; the President's Executive Order 13658 regarding minimum wages on federal funded construction contracts, the Civil Rights Act of 1964. Bidders must certify that they do not or will not maintain or provide for their employees any facilities that are segregated on the basis of race, color, creed, or national origin. In the event the lowest bid from any responsible bidder exceeds available funds, the General Manager, or his designee, is authorized and directed to undertake negotiations with such apparent low bidder to obtain a contract price within available funds. The General Manager or his designee may negotiate in person, by telephone, in writing or in any other manner deemed appropriate by the General Manager.

Bidders must comply with all applicable rules and regulations in reference to employment practices. The bidder shall include with his or her bid a copy of the Contractor's bid bond, acknowledgement of addendum(s) (if applicable), the completed "Bidders Qualification Statement", and the "Bidder Compliance Statement Regarding Equal Employment Opportunity" (Attachment #3 – Contract Inserts), and the EPA Subcontractor Forms (Attachment 6 – Contract Inserts) which are contained in the CONTRACT DOCUMENTS.
